Dear Mr. Alnimr:

A reinspection of M&M General Store located at 2971 720 Buffalo St., Shelby, North Carolina was conducted on November 7, 2008 by Food Regulatory Specialist Lawrence Thomas of this Department. This inspection revealed the continued presence of over the counter (OTC) medications being offered for sale past the use-by date. We specifically direct to your attention the following inspection observations:

1. The following products with an estimated value of one hundred thirty dollars (\$130.00) were placed under State Embargo FDC 0018472 pursuant to the North Carolina Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act. These products were voluntarily removed from sale and disposed of by management during inspection:
 - a. Four bottles of Pepto-Bismol @ 16 fl oz each, coded 627817951 Exp 08/2008.
 - b. One bottle of Member's Mark night time multi-symptom Cold/Flu relief @ 16 fl oz, coded 6JV0567 Exp 08/08.
 - c. Four (4) bottles of Member's Mark Non-drowsy Tussin DM cough formula @ 12 fl oz each, coded LMK0105 Exp 10/08.
 - d. Three boxes of Vicks Formula 44 Decongestant Cough and head congestion relief @ 4 fl oz Lot 003SG2 Exp Nov/2007.
 - e. One box of children's Vicks NyQuil cold and cough multi-symptom relief, Lot 5293SG1 Exp SE/07.
 - f. One can of Solarcaine First Aid Medicated spray @ 3 oz. net wt, coded 5M01A3 Exp 10/07.


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- g. Three boxes of Assured maximum strength Pseudo-Free Nasal decongestant @ 24 tablets each, coded 06B167 2-08.
- h. Two boxes of Assured maximum strength Pseudo-Free severe cold and cough @ 12 tablets each, coded 04K717 10-06.
- i. One box of Vick's Non-Drowsy DayQuil Liquicaps multi-symptom cold/flu relief, @ 12 liquicaps Lot 6108171961 exp 01/27/2008.
- j. One box of concentrated Motrin Infant's drops @ ½ fl oz, coded MBM06 Exp 01/08.
- k. One box of Nite Time multi-symptom cold and flu relief @ 10 softgels, coded R6101 Exp 06/08.
- l. Five boxes of Assured Children's chewable aspirin @ 36-81mg tablets each, coded 06D473 Exp Oct 08.
- m. Two sachets of Excedrin extra strength tablets @ 2 coated tablets each, coded 6S0025AT Exp 08/08.
- n. One packet of Stanback headache powder @ 6 powders, coded M500666 Exp 1/08.
- o. One bottle Coppertone Sun screen lotion @ 4 fl.oz, coded K4291 Exp 1007.

Review of our records reveals that similar objectionable conditions were documented at the facility during an inspection August 11, 2008 by Food Regulatory Specialist Lawrence Thomas of this Department.

We have directed this matter to your attention as Owner of M&M General Store in order that you might take immediate steps to correct the above-mentioned conditions and assure a continual safe and sanitary operation. Your written response outlining the actions you are taking will be anticipated by this office within fifteen (15) days of receiving this letter.
