Dear Mr. Fry:

An inspection of Country Boys Market, located at 3700 Poplar Tent Road, Concord, North Carolina was conducted on January 15, 2009 by Food Regulatory Specialist Teresa Blackwelder of this Department. This inspection, conducted in response to a complaint regarding an uninspected vendor in the facility, revealed the sale of uninspected low acid and acidified foods. We specifically direct to your attention the following items observed during the inspection:

One (1) pint of Chicken Soup, four (4) pints of Tomatoes, One (1) pint of Chunky Icicle Pickles, four (4) pints of Icicle Pickles, One (1) pint of Green Beans, two (2) pints of Chili, four (4) pints of homemade Chili, two (2) pints of Whole Kernel Corn, three (3) pints of Mixed Vegetables, one (1) pint of Sliced Carrots, two (2) pints of Pickled Okra, one (1) pint of B&B Peppers, three (3) pints of Northern White Beans with Ham, one (1) pint of Vegetable Soup, one (1) pint of Mixed Chow Chow, four (4) pints of Mild Salsa, two (2) pints of Pickled Beets, seven (7) pints of Sweet Potatoes, two (2) pints of Pumpkin, One (1) quart of Sweet Potatoes.

State Embargo FDC No. 0019252 with an estimated value of one hundred sixty five dollars (\$165.00) was issued on all food listed above due to the noncompliance to regulation. The products were voluntarily destroyed by the market management by placing them in the firm's dumpster.


A follow up inspection was conducted at your home based processing facility located at 803 Laura Avenue, Kannapolis, North Carolina, on January 28, 2009 by Food Regulatory Supervisor Eddie Radford of this Department. During this visit copies of 21CFR 110, 113, 114 and The Food and Drug Cosmetic Act were given to you that explain the regulations for compliance for your non-meat products.

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We agree with your decision on January 12, 2009 to voluntarily cease the sale of your products until the firm is placed under inspection by this Department.
