**CONSENT  
 PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

THIS MATTER having come before the undersigned District Court Judge Presiding on November 21, 2008 upon Plaintiffs' Motion for a Preliminary Injunction. Plaintiffs were represented by Alice C. Stubbs and Steve Mansbery of the law firm of Tharrington Smith, LLP. Defendant was represented by Deborah Sandlin of the law firm of Sandlin & Davidian, PA and Lynn A. Prather of the law firm of Kurtz & Blum, PLLC. The Court finds that a Temporary Restraining Order was entered by the Court in this matter on November 10, 2008. The parties agree to the entry of this Consent Preliminary Injunction without the necessity of findings of fact, each party understanding and intending to be bound by this Order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** as follows:


1. Defendant and his agents are enjoined, restrained and prohibited from concealing, liquidating, assigning, transferring, selling, or otherwise wasting or disposing of any and all of his remaining assets;
2. Defendant and his agents are enjoined, restrained and prohibited from further encumbering the assets presently owned by Defendant, including, but not limited to, the former marital residence and Defendant's 401(k);
3. Defendant and his agents are enjoined, restrained and prohibited from withdrawing, cashing out, transferring, encumbering or otherwise disposing of any assets presently owned by Defendant, including but not limited to, the former marital residence, checking and savings accounts in his or Nancy Cooper's separate or joint names, his 401(k) through Cisco, any funds which Defendant receives from Cisco, including, but not limited to, earnings, severance pay, stock options, stock grants and/or life insurance proceeds from Cisco, his brokerage accounts, and all other bank, stock and retirement accounts;
4. Defendant and his agents are enjoined, restrained and prohibited from withdrawing any funds on an equity line, line of credit or credit card secured by one of the aforementioned assets set forth in paragraph 3 immediately above;

5. Defendant and his agents are enjoined, restrained and prohibited from withdrawing any funds on an equity line, line of credit or credit card secured by one of the aforementioned assets set forth in paragraph 4 immediately above;


6. Notwithstanding the prohibition listed in the above paragraph, Defendant or his agents may list the former marital residence for sale during the pendency of this Injunction; provided however, the house shall be listed at a fair market value, as determined by the listing agent. If the former marital residence sells during the pendency of this Injunction, the net proceeds shall be held in escrow by counsel for Defendant pending further order of this Court;


7. The Court reserves jurisdiction over this matter for entry of such other further Orders as may be necessary or in the interest of justice.
