CONTINUATION OF A SEARCH WARRANT**

**IN THE MATTER Of: 1411 Sundown Drive, Mebane N.C. 27302**

**Probable Cause**

1. I, Christopher A. Robinson, hereinafter designated as Affiant, having been duly sworn according to law, deposes and says that: Affiant is a Durham Police Investigator, who is currently assigned to the Durham Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division. The Affiant has been a sworn law enforcement officer with the State of North Carolina for over 13 years. The Affiant has participated in and/or conducted numerous investigations involving crimes of violence to include but not limited to: aggravated assaults involving firearms and other weapons, robberies, sexual assaults, homicides and the physical and/or sexual abuse of children. Additionally, the Affiant has attended numerous schools throughout her tenure as a law enforcement officer.
2. On July 15, 2010 I investigator C.A. Robinson and Sgt. Perkins was notified by Orange County Sheriff Office that they had recovered some skeleton remains that were human. Speaking with Deputy T. White he advised that he spoke with a confidential informant and the informant stated to investigator T. White that Michael Dorman asked him to help him destroy and conceal human skeletal remains. Michael Dorman informed the informant that he had killed a female in Durham N.C. and that it happened two years ago. Investigator T. White then stated that on 1950 hours on 7/14/2010, investigator T. White witnessed Michael Dorman handing the informant a green book bag, the informant then put the book bag on an unmarked Orange County Sheriff Office truck. Investigator T. White then took possession of the book bag and it was transported to the Orange County Sheriff Department. Once at the Sheriff Department investigator T. White opened the bag and he observed what appeared to be human skeletal bones. At that time the green book bag with the human skeletal remains was secured at the Orange County Sheriff Office. I then was advised by investigator T. White that they were going to have the confidential informant spoke with Michael Dorman. While conducting a Surveillance Operation, Michael Dorman was brought back to Orange County Sheriff's Office and he was questioned in reference to his possession of the skeletal remains. I investigator C.A. Robinson then spoke with Michael Dorman and he stated that he had found the skeletal remains in Durham N.C. and he brought the remains back to Orange County.






