ON NOVEMBER 7, 1984, SA [ ] SBI, WAS CONTACTED AND ADVISED THAT HIS DEPARTMENT WAS CONTACTED BY STATION MANAGER [ ] WLFL TV, CHANNEL 22, DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA, THAT RECEPTIONIST [ ] HAD RECEIVED AN ANONYMOUS TELEPHONE CALL AT 9:02 A.M., ON NOVEMBER 7, 1984, FROM WHAT SOUNDED LIKE TO BE A BLACK FEMALE CALLER. THE CALLER APPEARED TO BE MIDDLE AGED, SPOKE VERY DISTINCTLY, AND APPEARED TO HAVE BEEN EDUCATED. THE CALLER MADE THE STATEMENT TO [ ] "I WILL KILL SENATOR HELMS AND BLOW ALL OF HIS BRAINS OVER HIS CAR." SA [ ] STATED THAT AT 10:05 A.M., NOVEMBER 7, 1984, HE FURNISHED THE ABOVE INFORMATION TO SERGEANT [ ] DURHAM, NORTH CAROLINA, POLICE DEPARTMENT. SA [ ] ADVISED THAT BECAUSE OF THE ANONYMOUS NATURE OF THE COMPLAINT, AND THE LACK OF LOGICAL LEADS, HIS OFFICE WAS NOT CONDUCTING AN ACTIVE INVESTIGATION BUT NOTED THAT THE SPECIFIC DETAILS OF THE THREAT AGAINST SENATOR HELMS WOULD BE INDEXED FOR FUTURE USE.

Re Charlotte teletype to Director, 11/7/84.

On 12/5/84, Major [redacted] Raleigh, North Carolina, Police Department, was recontacted regarding captioned matter and advised his department had furnished Senator HELMS a Varter Alarm System for the Senator's personal use while he was at his residence in Raleigh, North Carolina, previous to and shortly after the national election in November, 1984. The alarm system would give Senator HELMS immediate contact with the police department and Major [redacted] noted that Senator HELMS did not require the Police Department services and has returned to Washington, D. C.

On 1/22/85, [redacted] Administrative Assistant, United States Senator JESSE HELMS' Office, Raleigh, North Carolina, was contacted and advised that his office has received no additional complaints from the anonymous black female caller who had telephonically contacted TV Station WFLB in Durham, North Carolina. [redacted] related should his office obtain any additional information relative to this matter, that he would immediately contact the FBI Office in Raleigh, North Carolina.

In view of the fact that all logical investigation has been completed and in the absence of any logical leads to be covered, Charlotte considers this matter closed.
