UNITED STATES SENATOR JESSE HELMS -  
VICTIM  
CONGRESSIONAL ASSASSINATION STATUTE

On July 24, 1981, [REDACTED] Administrative Assistant to United States Senator JESSE HELMS from North Carolina, telephonically contacted the Raleigh-Durham, North Carolina, Resident Agency of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) from Wilmington, North Carolina, where the North Carolina Republican State Convention was being held at the Hilton Inn. He advised that on the afternoon of July 23, 1981, [REDACTED] North Carolina Republican Party, was approached by an individual known only as [REDACTED] demanded that [REDACTED] set up an appointment for him with Senator HELMS inasmuch as he needed to talk to the Senator about changing his radical ways because, if he (HELMS) did not do so, he would "shoot the son-of-a-bitch." [REDACTED] noted that Senator HELMS was scheduled to arrive in Wilmington, North Carolina, on July 25, 1981, as was Secretary of the Interior WATT and Office of Management and Budget Director DAVID STOCKMAN.

According to [REDACTED] was believed to be a guest at the hotel and possibly attending the convention. He was also thought to be from Carteret County, North Carolina. He had no other identifying data regarding [REDACTED]

On July 24, 1981, United States Secret Service (USSS), Special Agent [REDACTED] Raleigh, North Carolina; [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Wilmington, North Carolina, Police Department; and [REDACTED] Raleigh, North Carolina, Police Department were advised of the threat. SA [REDACTED] specifically was advised that the FBI was not conducting active investigation in the matter.

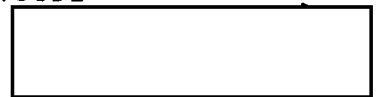

MISCELLANEOUS CONCERNING

On 6/13/84 [redacted] telephonically advised SAC that he desires to meet with an FBI Agent to furnish information regarding various violations on the east coast in the vicinity of [redacted]. He indicated he is [redacted] in that area and that he has information concerning corruption and illegal drug trafficking. Without being specific, he indicated that some individuals might be Deputy Sheriffs and individuals connected with Probation Department at some level. He indicated that late [redacted]

[redacted] SAC inquired as to whether ATF or SBI had not investigated the explosion, and he indicated they had not and that the local Sheriff interfered with any other agency conducting investigation. According to [redacted]

He indicated his address is [redacted] N. C., and his telephone is [redacted]

Charlotte indices indicate Charlotte file 89A-227 involved possible threat to U. S. Senator JESSE HELMS during 1981, with [redacted] identified as possible subject. This involved approaching a member of the Republican Party at the State Convention in 1981 and demanding an appointment with Senator HELMS in order to discuss changing his radical ways because if he (HELMS) did not do so [redacted] threatened to shoot him. Other references indicate [redacted] Aka. [redacted] DOB [redacted] addressed Klan gatherings in eastern North Carolina in 1968 [redacted] [redacted] Has also allegedly threatened various U. S. Presidents in the past and U. S. Secret Service is aware.

[redacted] According to letter, condemnation proceedings were attended by representative of Sheriff's Department, SBI and County Fire Marshal, and all indicated they had no record of any investigation pending. By letter dated 10/6/83, SAC, Charlotte, advised Carteret County that FBI likewise had no investigation pending concerning the fire bombing.

[redacted] was advised that SRA [redacted] of our Greenville Office, would be in contact with him soon to elicit any information pertinent to a Federal violation over which FBI has jurisdiction after which SA [redacted] or another Agent would meet with him personally in the event such information was available.
