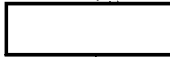

On 1/14/86, [redacted] was found guilty by a jury in U.S. DISTRICT COURT (USDC), Raleigh, North Carolina, of mailing threatening communications to Senator HELMS in violation of Title 18, U.S. Code, Section 876.

On 3/17/86, [redacted] was sentenced by USDC Judge W. EARL BRITT, Eastern District of North Carolina (EDNC), to five years probation and the costs of prosecution. As a term of probation, [redacted] was ordered to attend a local mental health center for consultation and guidance as determined by the Probation Office.
