politically controversial person and feels that Senator Helms
is a racist and bigot, however, does not recall making any
statement that he would kill Senator Helms or would send anyone
to kill Senator Helms. [redacted] advised that he had no
intention to kill Helms or to have anyone kill Helms, and anyone
overhearing his conversation who understood him to say that would
have been mistaken.

AUSA [redacted] would decline prosecution
in this matter as it does not appear to constitute a federal
violation and [redacted] comments were merely a political commentary.
