

## DRAFT SCHEDULE

**Wednesday July 13**, noon, House and Senate convene.

- 1) House Bill 183 ratified
- 2) Veto messages read
- 3) Joint resolution adopted adjourning session until Friday July 22. (quorum not required – recess and adjournment can be done without quorum –we have adopted adjournment resolutions before by voice vote without quorum) – if no joint resolution then members collect per diem until session reconvenes and there has to be a session every three days

**Thursday, July 21**

- 1) 10 am to noon Joint House and Senate Redistricting Committees meet to hear presentation on congressional plan and have preliminary discussion
- 2) 2 pm to 4 pm Senate Redistricting Committee meets to hear presentation on Senate plan 5 pm to 7 pm House Redistricting Committee meets to hear presentation on House plan
- 3) 8 pm to 10 pm House Redistricting Committee meets to hear presentation on House plan

**Friday, July 22**

- 1) 10 am to noon Senate Redistricting Committee meets for discussion on Congressional Plan and begins consideration of amendments
- 2) 1 pm session convenes.
- 3) 2 pm to 4 pm Senate Redistricting Committee meets for discussion on Senate Plan and begins consideration of amendments
- 4) 5 pm to 7 pm House Redistricting Committee meets for discussion on House Plan and begins consideration of amendments

**Saturday, July 23**

- 1) 10 am to noon Senate Redistricting Committee meets for discussion on Congressional Plan and amendments, favorable report on PCS
- 2) 2 pm to 4 pm House Redistricting Committee meets for discussion on House Plan and amendments
- 3) 5 pm to 7 pm Senate Redistricting Committee meets for discussion on Senate Plan and amendments
- 4) 7 pm session to report in bills (may drop back to Sunday session with no votes to report in bills if staff needs time to prepare)

**Monday, July 25**

- 1) 8 am session convenes. Senate begins consideration of Congressional Plan, House begins consideration of House plan
- 2) Afternoon session for other business (election law subjects, conference reports, veto override votes)

**Tuesday, July 26**

- 1) 9 am session convenes. Senate passes Congressional Plan, House passes House plan
- 2) Afternoon floor session for other business (election law subjects, conference reports, veto override votes)

- 3) Evening House redistricting committee meets on Congressional Plan, Senate redistricting committee meets on House Plan

**Wednesday, July 27**

- 1) 9 am session convenes. Senate passes Senate plan, House considers Congressional Plan
- 2) Afternoon floor session for other business (election law subjects, conference reports, veto override votes)
- 3) Late afternoon House redistricting committee meets on Senate plan
- 4) Early evening floor session, Senate passes House plan. House passes Congressional Plan and Senate plan.
- 5) If differences in plans, conferees meet.

**Thursday, July 28**

- 1) House passes Senate plan if not done Wednesday.
- 2) Adoption of conference reports on redistricting if needed.
- 3) Adjournment resolution over to constitutional amendments session.
