13.4	Drug Manufacturer Licensing and Registration Fees	07/01/2015	\$ 550,000	Increases annual registration fees for out-of-state companies operating as manufacturers or repackagers from \$500 to \$1000 and as wholesalers from \$350 to \$700. Increases annual licensure application fees for in-state companies operating as manufacturers from \$500 to \$1000 and for any other person from \$350 to \$700. Fees were last raised in 1988.
13.5	Food Manufacturer and Retailer Inspection Fees	07/01/2015	\$ 35,000	Increases annual inspection fees for dairy retailers from \$10 to \$50 and for wholesalers from \$40 to \$100.
15.13	Repeal Apprenticeship Fee	07/01/2015	0	Eliminates \$50 fee (initial registration & annual requirement) for participants in the Apprenticeship program.
14.10	Shellfish Cultivation Leasing Reform	When act becomes law.	Less than \$3,600	Extends the duration of a shellfish lease from five to ten years. Shellfish renewal fees are \$100 – every 5 years for contract/renewals after 2009 and every 10 years for contracts issued prior to 2009. Impact is minimal.
14.10B	SCFL Exemption for Employees of Leaseholder	When act becomes law.	Unknown	Allows an employee of a shellfish leaseholder holding a valid SCFL (standard commercial fishing license) to take shellfish without a license from an area leased for cultivation of shellfish. The number shellfish license holders who also are employees of a shellfish leaseholder holding a valid SCFL is unknown. Background: Currently, anyone who harvests shellfish from a leased area must obtain a \$50 shellfish license or have a SCFL with a shellfish endorsement.
14.10C	Water Column Leasing Clarification		Less than \$5,000	Amends leases for shellfish cultivation to specify that the lease includes the right to place devices or equipment related to the cultivation or harvesting of marine resources on or within 18 inches of the leased bottom. Devices that don't attach to the bottom or extend above 18 inches of above the leased bottom would still require a water column lease. The effect of this amendment is that potentially fewer water column leases would be needed. In FY 2013-14, a total of 26 water column leases made payments totaling \$4,530.

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14.20	Landfill Changes	07/01/2016	\$ (260,359)	Replaces existing permit fee structure for solid waste management facilities with a new fee permit fee structure based on an annual permit fee. New fee structure is estimated to generate approximately \$26,000 less than the current fee structure based on a 3-year average of collections. Also extends the duration of permits for sanitary landfills and transfer stations to a facility's life-of site permits (from the current option for a 5- or 10-year permit).

14.26	Reform Civil Penalties Under the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act	When act becomes law.	Unknown	Sets a maximum cumulative total civil penalty of \$25,000 for first time violators of the Sedimentation Pollution Control Act.

20.1	Insurance Regulatory Charge	01/01/2016	0	Keeps the Insurance Regulatory Charge at the current rate of 6.5%. The fee is expected to generate approximately \$33.5 million, which is the same amount of revenue received from the current rate; therefore, there is no net fiscal impact.

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27.8	Driver License/Duplicate Fees	07/01/2015	\$275,000 (Highway Fund)	Changes the recipient fund from the License to Give Trust Fund to the Highway Fund. Rates are unchanged.

12E.5	Increase in North Carolina Medical Examiner Autopsy Fee	10/01/2015	\$585,000	Amends G.S. 130A-389(a) to increase the autopsy fee charged by the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner from \$1,250 to \$2,800. This fee is charged for autopsies/studies deemed advisable by the chief medical examiner or medical examiner investigating a case, or requested by the district attorney or a superior court judge. Sec. (a)(1) directs that counties shall pay only \$1,750 of this fee.
12E.6	Increase in Medical Examiner Fee	10/01/2015	\$ (110,000)	Increases the fee for reports by the county medical examiners from \$100 to \$200 per case.
12G.3	Licensure of Overnight Respite Facilities			Adds adult day care and adult day health overnight respite facilities to the list of construction projects on which a review fee is imposed. The amount of the fee is \$225 per facility
12H.4	Provider Application and Recredentialing Fee		\$ -	Maintains the application and triennial re-credentialing application fee of \$100 (plus federally required amounts) by the Division of Medical Assistance (Medicaid) to charge for application by each provider enrolling in the Medicaid Program for the first time. The fee is expected to generate approximately \$1.5 million, which is the same amount of revenue received from the current fee; therefore, there is no net fiscal impact.
