## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

### FOR PUBLIC USE OF THE EXECUTIVE MANSION

*The individual signing the Agreement for Usage Form agrees to abide by these policies.*

#### A. USAGE

1. Only civic and cultural groups, political groups, non-profit organizations, and local, state and federal government agencies may use the Executive Mansion.
2. The premises may be used ONLY for meetings, receptions, teas, luncheons or dinners. Weddings, political campaign events, and fundraising events are strictly prohibited.
3. All events are subject to approval by the Office of the Governor. The Office of the Governor reserves the right to cancel any event at any time. Events may be cancelled due to inclement weather or should the Governor have other uses for the Mansion.
4. All guests shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times. The Director of the Executive Mansion reserves the right to conclude any event at any time due to excessive noise or inappropriate behavior in whatever form by any Mansion guests.
5. The State Ethics Act prohibits the use of the Governor's name or title in advertisements. To ensure compliance with this prohibition, and to prevent the perception of the Governor endorsing a particular group or cause, guests holding events at the Mansion may not advertise or promote their event in newspapers, radio, television, or other public media. Groups may promote their event among their potential invitees only.
6. There is a 1.5-hour time limit on events. An exception could be granted in special circumstances. Due to high demand for the residence, events must begin and end promptly as scheduled. Guests will not be admitted to the Mansion prior to the scheduled start time of the event.
7. Maximum capacity for indoor events is 230 people for a stand up reception, and 80 people for a seated meal. If the weather permits we can seat people on the porch and can then raise the number to 100 for a seated event.
8. All food is provided and served by the Executive Mansion.
9. Smoking anywhere on the property is prohibited.
10. Events at the Executive Mansion are limited to using only the first floor and the grounds.
11. No pets are allowed in the residence or on the grounds.
12. No alcohol is permitted on Mansion grounds.
13. The Executive Mansion will not be responsible for any items or property belonging to guests that are lost, stolen, damaged, or destroyed while on the Mansion premises.
14. Guests of the Mansion agree to hold harmless the State of North Carolina, along with its agents and employees, from any liability or loss resulting from any personal injury or property damage sustained while a guest at the Mansion.

**B. ARRANGEMENTS**

1. Reservation requests may be made by calling the Director of the Executive Mansion at 919-733-3070 extension 253. Reservations will be taken no more than 60 days in advance.
2. The Mansion is available for use on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 8:30am until 8:30pm. It is closed on all State Holidays.
3. The Mansion Director will be on the premises for all functions. During functions, the Mansion Director will have free access to all rooms occupied by those attending the function.
4. Telephone Use: Please plan to use a cell phone for making and receiving calls at the Mansion.
5. The Mansion staff will be on the premises for all functions and will be responsible for cleaning the premises and the removal of garbage after each event.
6. There is no parking on the Executive Mansion grounds. During the workday, on-street parking is very limited. After 5 p.m. each day, on-street parking surrounding the Mansion is usually readily available. There are also public parking lots within walking distance of the Mansion, including the lot at Jones and Edenton Streets.

**C. RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Furnishings in the Mansion cannot be moved or rearranged. Please do not ask staff to do so.
2. The Mansion will be inspected before and after each use. The contact person is responsible and will be billed for any costs associated with replacing, repairing, or cleaning broken or damaged items.

Admittance

Due to security requirements, no one will be admitted to the event whose name does not appear on the list of expected guests. Picture ID is required. There are no exceptions to this policy.


Event Time

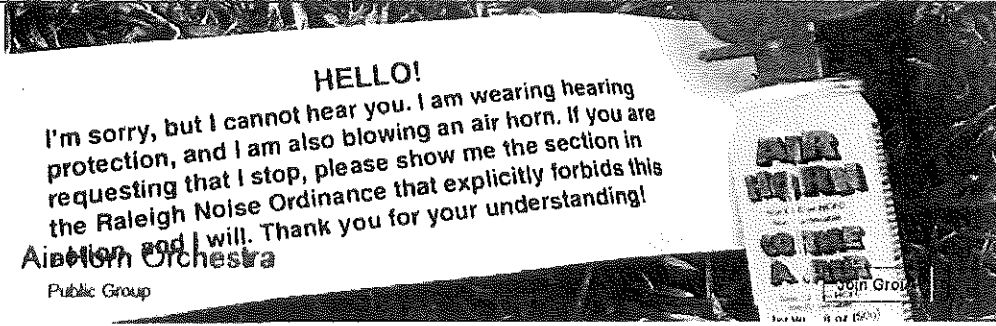

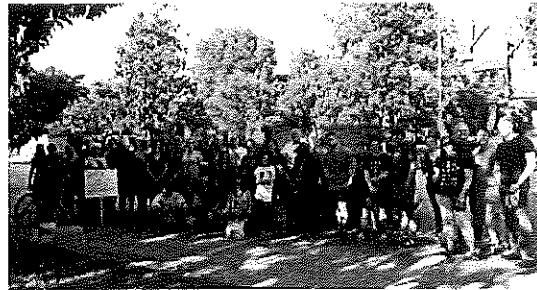

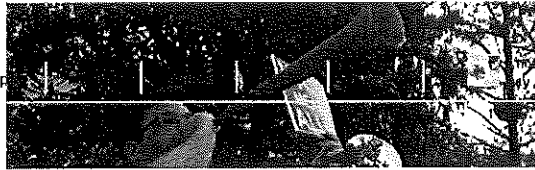
