Dear Ms. Beasley:

An inspection of TJ's Market located at 2197 Colington Rd., Kill Devil Hill, North Carolina was conducted on July 24, 2008 by Food Regulatory Specialist William Creps of this Department. This inspection revealed the presence of objectionable and insanitary food storage conditions. We specifically direct to your attention the following inspection observations:

1. The following products with an estimated value of one hundred fifteen (\$115) were placed under State Embargo FDC 0017368 pursuant to the North Carolina Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act. These products were voluntarily removed from sale and disposed of by management during inspection:
 - a. Two (2) 13 oz. cans of Enfamil with Iron Use By 1 Dec 07.
 - b. Two (2) 24 caplet packs Extra Strength Doan's Exp: 01/08
 - c. Five (5) 2 tablet Dramamine Chewable Formula Exp 01/2007
 - d. Six (6) 2 tablet Dramamine Chewable Formula Exp 06/2008
 - e. Fifteen (15) 2 tablet Anacin Exp 03/2008
 - f. Twenty three (23) 10 tablet packs Anacin Exp 10/07
 - g. One (1) 2 liquicap Vicks Day Quil Exp Au/07
2. Packaged slaw, macaroni, potato and chicken salads and deviled eggs were observed offered for self-service retail sale with no labels. Compliant labels should include:
 - a. Common name of product.
 - b. Net weight
 - c. Ingredient declaration with ingredients listed in order of predominance by weight including constituents.
 - d. Name, address and phone number of manufacturer.

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3. The ice machine on the left in the back storage room has a black mold-like substance on the deflector plate inside the ice cabinet.

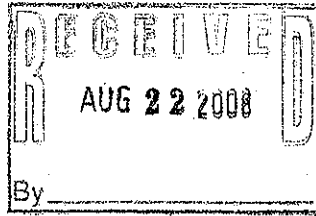
