**VIOLATION:** Robbery

**PROBABLE CAUSE:**

I Detective G.R. Bowman have been a Law Enforcement Officer with the Raleigh Police Department for 14 year's 5 months. I am currently assigned to the Investigations Division. I completed Basic Law Enforcement Training at the Raleigh Police Academy and have received in --service training through the Raleigh Police Department since that time. I have received specialized training through the North Carolina Justice Academy and the Raleigh Police Academy on topics such as Laws of Arrest, Search and Seizure and the preparation of search warrants and Criminal Investigations. During my career as a law enforcement officer, I have been involved in the investigation, arrest and conviction of numerous persons charged with assorted criminal violations violations.

On 4-22-05 and 4-29-05 there were armed robberies at Ora Jewelers and Perry Brothers Jewelers in Raleigh, N.C.. Three suspects entered the stores brandishing a handgun and demanded the employees to get on the ground. The employees were handcuffed while the suspects smashed out the jewelery cases and took the merchandise. Prior to the Ora Jewelery store robberies a female subject came in the store acting suspicious. She was inquiring about having some earrings repaired. One of the employees made a mental note of the jewelery she was wearing. In particular a watch that the employee complimented the female subject on who responded that her husband had given it to her. The female subject left her name and cell number. One of the suspects was seen by this same employee wearing a male version of the watch the female subject had been wearing. As part of the follow up investigation a court order inquiring about the subscriber information of the cell phone was obtained. The subscriber information was provided by the carrier. One of the suspects was developed after receiving this information. The subscriber of the cell phone was a Vincent Sumpter. Sumpter was wanted out of New York for robbery and had a history of same. A photo was obtained from the New York Police Department and a photo line up with Sumpter was shown to the employee at Ora Jewelers and one at Perry Brothers. Both employees positively identified Vincent Sumpter as one of the suspects.

There is probable cause to conduct a search so that evidence of the crime of Armed Robbery, and the true identity of the suspects can be sought , located and seized. Based on the facts described herein and upon my observations, training, and experience, it is my opinion that probable cause exists to conclude that the evidence described in this application is located at the places to be searched as described herein.

**DESCRIPTION OF ITEMS TO BE SEIZED:**

1. Evidence of ownership or possession of premises located at 3633 Meadow Creek Ln.
2. Evidence of fingerprints, jewelery, and any other evidence pertaining to the crime of robbery.
3. Weapons, bullets, handguns, firearms, clothing, communication devices and documents, any cell phones or electronic device, U.S. Currency.
