
1. On November 3, 2008, Defendant filed his Motion to Seal Temporary Custody Order.
2. On November 13, 2008, after filing a Motion for Leave to Intervene, Capitol Broadcasting Company, Incorporated and the News and Observer Publishing Company (hereinafter referred to as the "Intervenors") submitted a Memorandum in Opposition to Motion to Seal.
3. Plaintiffs and their counsel have reviewed the Intervenors' Memorandum.
4. For the reasons set forth in the Intervenors' Memorandum, Defendant's Motion to Seal Temporary Custody Order should be denied.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Court:

1. Deny Defendant's Motion to Seal Temporary Custody Order and in the Alternative to Stay Public Filing and Dissemination Awaiting Appellate Review Regarding Sealing of Temporary Custody Order;
2. Award Plaintiffs the reasonable attorney's fee incurred by their attorneys to prosecute this objection;
3. Tax the costs of this action to Defendant; and
4. Grant Plaintiffs any and all other relief that the Court deems just and proper.


