

Facts to Establish Probable Cause

I, Charles E. Sole Jr., hereafter referenced as Affiant, upon my oath, hereby depose and say as follows:

1. At present, your Affiant is a member of the City of Durham Police Department assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division, Homicide Unit. Your Affiant has been a sworn law enforcement officer for more than fifteen years. Your Affiant's prior assignments include: Patrol Officer in the Uniform Patrol Bureau, a member of Crime Area Target Team, as well as assignments as a Police Canine Handler. Your Affiant has also served as a Detective in the Special Operations Division (Vice and Narcotics Enforcement) with assignments on the Street Crimes Unit, Major Crimes Unit and the Narcotic Interdiction Unit. Your Affiant has participated directly or indirectly in numerous criminal investigations, which have been prosecuted in the state and federal courts.
2. Your Affiant has basic and advanced law enforcement certificates issued by the North Carolina Department of Justice Education and Training Standards Commission. Your Affiant applied for and has been appointed to the rank of Master Officer. Your Affiant has attended and successfully completed the North Carolina Justice Academy, Police Law Institute course (PLI), which covered the mechanics of arrest, search and investigation.
3. Your Affiant has attended and successfully completed several basic and advanced courses connected to law enforcement investigator/detective training. This training included but was not limited to, interview and interrogation, surveillance operations, narcotics investigation, criminal investigation, homicide investigation and crime scene management. Your Affiant has drafted or assisted in drafting numerous search warrants and associated affidavits which have been reviewed and signed by local Magistrates, North Carolina Superior Court Judges and United States Federal Magistrate Judges.



4. The information contained in this Affidavit is based on your Affiant's personal investigative efforts and the efforts of other officers and detectives with the Durham Police Department. Your Affiant has also received information regarding this investigation from other local, state and federal law enforcement agents/officers as well as other reliable sources of information. Since this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing a search warrant, your Affiant has not included each and every fact known concerning this investigation.
5. That this investigation was predicated by a complaint of suspicious activity involving Pete Moses, Vania Sisk, Shelia Moses, Larhonda Smith, Lavada Q. Harris, P. Leonard Moses and others who resided at 2109 Pear Tree Lane Durham, NC. According to numerous witnesses, police reports from this jurisdiction and elsewhere, child services records, and other creditable sources of information, the above mentioned individuals were directly involved in or party to information regarding the murder of a Jadon Higginbotham, a 4 year old child, and Antoinette McKoy, 28 year old adult. These incidents were reported to have occurred at 2109 Pear Tree Lane Durham, NC.
6. That Pete Moses, Vania Sisk, Shelia Moses, Larhonda Smith, Lavada Q. Harris, P. Leonard Moses and others that resided at 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC. It has been discovered that Jadon Higginbotham and Antoinette McKoy also lived at 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC. According to witnesses, Higginbotham was last seen alive in October of 2010, and McKoy was last seen alive in December of 2010.
7. That Vania Sisk, the mother of Jadon Higginbotham, has given numerous conflicting and untruthful statements regarding the whereabouts of Jadon to several different law enforcement agencies in Colorado and Durham, NC, as well as the Department of Social Services and to her own family. Sisk claims that sometime in mid February 2011, before moving to Colorado she left Jadon with a female in Durham. Sisk was not able to supply the name, address or legitimate contact information for this person that was taking care of Jadon. Sisk stated that the person was a





black female, with braided hair, driving a red car and believed to reside somewhere on Roxboro Road in Durham, NC.

8. On or about March 2, 2011, Sisk travelled back to Durham NC from Colorado via a commercial bus line. Sisk related to law enforcement that she came back to Durham, NC to look for Jadon. However Sisk used a false name of Sherena Smith (passenger number 71798672), when booking her travel and purchasing her bus ticket. In addition, when law enforcement officials boarded the bus that Sisk was travelling on, she was found hiding partially underneath a bus seat. Sisk did not have a cell phone with her, and she never called the police to file a missing person report. To this date, Sisk has never made any inquiry into the missing person investigation regarding her son. Based on your affiant's experience and training in the area of missing persons investigations, this conduct is unusual and suspicious.
9. That during the month of December 2010, a witness saw McKoy being forced back into the 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC by two females as well as a male. The witness related that the two females lived at 2109 Pear Tree Lane and the male was Pete Moses. Moreover, when Pete Moses, Vania Sisk, Larhonda Smith, Lavada Q. Harris, Shelia Moses and P. Leonard Moses and others were asked by law enforcement about McKoy, they denied even knowing her. However, many records and witnesses relate that McKoy resided at 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC. According to other records and interviews, it is evident that McKoy often kept in constant contact with her friends and family. This steady contact ceased shortly after McKoy was seen being forced back into 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC.
10. That another witness related to law enforcement that sometime in December 2010, McKoy was assaulted and shot in the second floor master bathroom at 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC. Investigators and Agents have searched 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC several times. During these searches, evidence of an assault was discovered in second floor master bathroom and elsewhere inside 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham NC. That Law enforcement officials have recovered latent, biological, trace and other evidence. The evidence includes, but is not limited to, a fired bullet, shell casing, as well as the presence of obvious cleaning in the second floor


11. That Lavada Q. Harris (aka PINS) was a resident at 2109 Pear Tree Lane, Durham, NC when the aforementioned incident occurred. At this point, Lavada Q. Harris (aka PINS) is considered a suspect in this investigation.
12. That as a part of this ongoing investigation into violations North Carolina General Statutes it is material and relevant to conduct supplemental forensic exams of the afore mentioned evidence. In order to complete the supplemental exams of certain evidence recovered in this investigation, it is required to obtain a DNA standard from Lavada Q. Harris (aka PINS).
13. Based on the facts and circumstances listed in this affidavit, your Affiant respectfully requests that the COURTS issue a search warrant for a salvia sample from Lavada Q. Harris (aka PINS). Furthermore, this COURT finds that probable cause is present to approach, detain and obtain the salvia sample from Lavada Q. Harris (aka PINS). Additionally, if Lavada Q. Harris (aka PINS) does not submit to this order of the COURT, reasonable force may be used by law enforcement to obtain the requested samples.

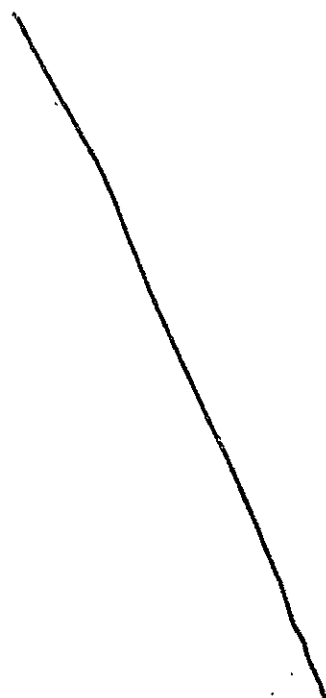
