6. Pagers, telephone records, cellular telephones, and information stored within electronic storage devices, including laptop computers and handheld computers.
7. Any and all evidence that may relate to the crime in question.

SECTION IV: FACTS TO ESTABLISH PROBABLE CAUSE

1. I, Detective J.D. Faulk, hereby swear and affirm that the following affidavit is based upon my personal knowledge, training, and experience as a sworn law enforcement officer and upon factual information that I have received from other persons as hereinafter described.

I have been a sworn law enforcement officer for twelve years and am currently assigned to the Homicide Unit within the Investigative Division of the Raleigh Police Department. During my experience, I have been involved in a variety of investigations including homicides, robberies, shootings, stabbings, missing persons, and deceased persons. I have received specialized training through the Raleigh Police Department concerning laws of arrest, search and seizure as well as the preparation of search warrants.

2. On Monday, July 18, 2011, the Kinston Police Department in Kinston, North Carolina received a report that Laura Jean Ackerson was missing. Her last known contact was reported to be during the week before.

The Kinston Police Department initiated a missing person investigation and developed information that Laura Jean Ackerson drove to Raleigh, North Carolina on July 13, 2011. The purpose of the trip was to meet with her children and their father, Grant Hayes aka Grant Haze at the premises to be searched. Her vehicle was identified as a 2006 Ford Focus, North Carolina Registration ZTL-7433, VIN: . Members of the Kinston Police Department spoke with Grant Hayes aka Grant Haze concerning the meeting with Laura Ackerson. He confirmed that Laura Ackerson arrived to his residence on July 13, 2011. Her last confirmed whereabouts are at 4021-322 Bella Park Trl, the premises to be searched.

The Kinston Police Department solicited the assistance of the Raleigh Police Department regarding the missing person investigation. On July 19, 2011, Raleigh Police officers located the missing person's vehicle in the parking lot of 5400 Summit Manor Lane. This location is within the city limits of Raleigh, NC and falls in the jurisdictional boundaries of the Raleigh Police Department.

3. The background investigation revealed that Laura Ackerson is the mother of two children. Grant Hayes aka Grant Haze is reportedly the father of the two children. According to Laura Ackerson's close friends and associates, she is extremely punctual and always "checks in" with her friends regarding her whereabouts. On July 13, 2011, Laura Ackerson had previously arranged to meet with a friend in Cary, NC after meeting with her children's father, Grant Hayes in Raleigh. Laura Ackerson failed to arrive at the friend's residence in Cary, NC at the predetermined time. Laura Ackerson's lack of communication with her friends, business partner(s), and family lead them to suspect foul play involved.

On February 21, 2011, Grant Haze aka Grant Hayes filed a child abuse report with the Raleigh Police Department. Grant Haze aka Grant Hayes indicated in the report that he lived at 4021-322 Bella Park Trl. Raleigh NC, the premises to be searched. This residence is within approximately 400 yards from where Laura Ackerson's vehicle was located.

4. On July 20, 2011, members of the Raleigh Police Department conferred with office personnel at the apartment complex of the premises to be searched. Office personnel indicated that the lease holder on the apartment is Amanda Smith. The apartment has been rented by Amanda Smith since May of 2010. The investigation has revealed that Amanda Smith is Grant Hayes' current wife. Office personnel are able to describe a black male similar to Grant Hayes' features and characteristics living with Amanda Smith.

Respectfully, I request this search warrant be issued to search for evidence described in the aforementioned premises to aid in the missing person investigation of Laura Ackerson.


