

during the Whites' vacation. Joe White said he knew that Heather, his girls, and he liked the dogs. Joe White asked me whether my family and I would be willing to play with the dogs and throw the ball for the dogs in the Whites' fenced-in backyard during the daytime throughout the Whites' vacation. I told Joe White I would be glad to do this. Joe White never told me that no children were allowed to play with the dogs during this time, and I never agreed to any such instruction, as no such instruction was given.

8. At Joe White's request, I provided him with a proposed four-digit pass code to be added as an access code for the Whites' home security system. Joe White then programmed his security system to accept this code for admission to the Whites' house.

9. After the April 27, 2021 attack, I learned that that the dogs had a history of aggressive, dangerous, and hostile behavior. I was not aware of this before the attack.

10. The emotional impact of Jayden's death has been devastating for me and Heather. Life will never be the same and we will miss Jayden every day for the rest of our lives.

11. Heather and I were shocked when we learned that the Whites were attempting to get the dogs back. These dogs are killers. The untrue things that the Whites have asserted about us when communicating with the Town and in the lawsuit filed on Tuesday has been very difficult to understand. The possibility that the dogs could be released/freed and returned to the Whites, through litigation or a decision from the Town, is deeply upsetting. If the dogs were to be released/freed, it would cause additional mental and emotional distress, both in knowing that the animals that killed Jayden are out there and in concern for the potential of another attack causing more injury. I feel strongly that Heather and I, as the parents of our daughter who was killed by these dogs, are victims in this case.

12. As the victims immediately affected by the dog attack, Heather and I feel a moral obligation to people everywhere to oppose the release of these dogs to the Whites or to anyone else. We believe very strongly that regardless of the precautions the Whites might take to prevent the dogs from ever being exposed to any other person again, there is no guarantee that the dogs might not escape.
