Instructions

This questionnaire is designed to obtain information about your qualifications to sit as a juror in a pending criminal case. Your responses to the questions will assist the Judge and the lawyers in selecting a jury.

Answer the questions without any help from or discussion with anyone else. Staff from the Clerk's office will be available to provide housekeeping and logistical information, but they cannot tell you how to answer a question, explain a question to you, or discuss your answers.

Answer all the questions truthfully and to the best of your ability. There are no right or wrong answers. Do not assume that any of your answers will qualify you or disqualify you from serving on this jury. We rely on your truthfulness to ensure a fair trial.

Where indicated, check the space for "Yes" or "No," and, as requested, furnish answers, explanations, or details in the space provided. Print or write answers clearly in blue or black ink.

Do not leave any question unanswered. If you do not understand any question or do not know the answer, please write, "I do not understand," or "I do not know," in the space provided for the answer. If you believe that any of the questions do not apply to you, please write, "Not Applicable" or "N/A" in the space provided. **If you want your answer to a particular question kept private, please indicate that and then answer the question.** If a question asks about your friends or family, do not list the name; you can identify him/her by relationship (husband, son, neighbor, friend, etc.).

If there is not enough space for you to write out an answer, please continue your answer in the margin next to the question, or use the space provided at the end of the questionnaire. **DO NOT WRITE ON THE BACK OF ANY PAGE.**

After you leave the courthouse, do not discuss the questionnaire or your answers with anyone. Remember the Court's instructions not to communicate about this case with anyone and not to read or listen to any news reports or discussion about the case.

United States v. Edwards

The criminal case about to be tried is the result of charges brought against John Edwards based on alleged violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act. Generally speaking, the allegations in this case are that Mr. Edwards received contributions in excess of the limit allowed by law and failed to report such contributions to the Federal Election Commission. Mr. Edwards denies the charges and has entered a plea of Not Guilty, he is presumed to be innocent, and the government bears the burden of proving his guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
