[REDACTED] ADVISED THAT SUBJECT, WHO IS RETIRED FROM THE U.S. ARMY, WAS STAYING ON AAFB FOR AN OVERNIGHT STAY IN THE BARRACKS.

SUBJECT'S ROOMMATE, [REDACTED] ADVISED THAT SUBJECT TOLD HIM THAT [REDACTED] HAS GUNS AND EXPLOSIVES AND WAS GOING TO KILL HELMS AND O'NEILL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. FOLLOWING SUBJECT'S STATEMENTS TO [REDACTED] CONTACTED OSI.

SUBJECT WAS INTERVIEWED BY FBI, HYATTSVILLE AT AAFB AND PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION: SUBJECT ADVISED HE CAME TO AAFB FEBRUARY 16, 1986 AND HAS BEEN ON THE BASE SINCE THEN. ON FEBRUARY 18, 1986 HE WENT TO THE OFFICE OF SENATOR HELMS PROVIDING HIM WITH WRITTEN DOCUMENTS REGARDING FARM POLICY BUDGETS. HE ALSO PROVIDED THIS POLICY TO THE OFFICE OF CONGRESSMAN O'NEILL AND ALSO SENT A COPY TO THE WHITE HOUSE. SUBJECT SAID HE THEN RETURNED TO AAFB AND DENIES MAKING ANY THREATENING REMARKS TO [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] SUBJECT ADVISED HE HAS THE HIGHEST REGARD FOR THE CONGRESSMAN AND THE SENATOR AND DOES NOT KNOW WHY [REDACTED] WOULD MAKE UP SUCH A STORY. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT SUBJECT APPEARED TO BE VERY INCOHERENT AND POSSIBLY MIGHT HAVE SOME MENTAL PROBLEMS.

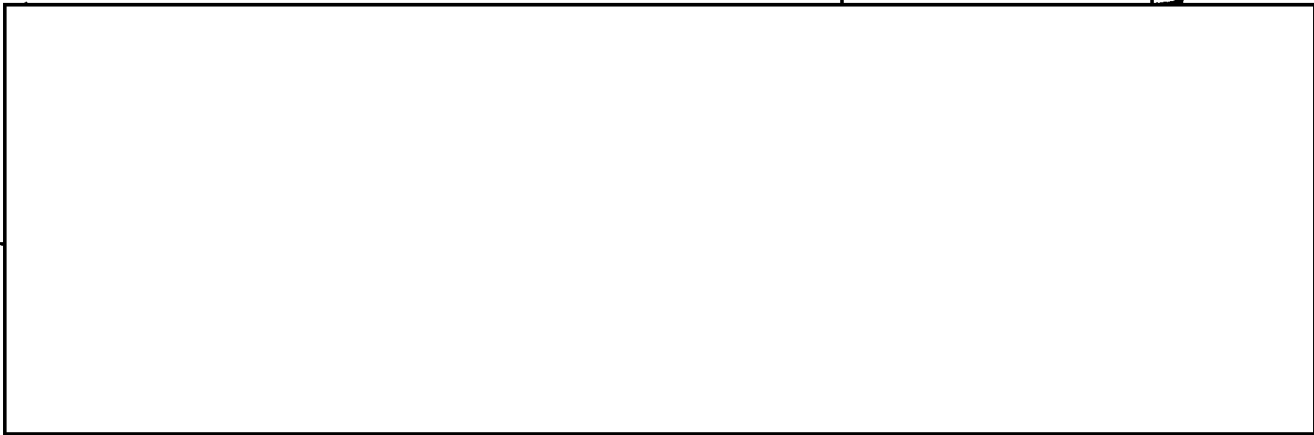

WASHINGTON, D.C., WAS ADVISED OF THE THREATS MADE BY THE SUBJECT AND [REDACTED] THEREAFTER WENT TO AAFB. [REDACTED] INTERVIEWED SUBJECT AND ALSO TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS, ADVISING SUBJECT THAT IF ANY VISITS WERE TO BE MADE TO THE CAPITOL HILL OFFICE BUILDINGS SUBJECT SHOULD CALL [REDACTED] ADVISED INTERVIEWING AGENT THAT HE WOULD NOTIFY THE OFFICES OF THE VICTIMS AND ALERT THEM TO THE THREATS MADE BY THE SUBJECT. SUBJECT, FOLLOWING INTERVIEW BY U.S. CAPITOL POLICE [REDACTED] WAS ESCORTED OFF AAFB.

THE FACTS OF THIS MATTER WERE PRESENTED TO AUSA KATHERINE ARMENTROUT WHO DECLINED PROSECUTION OF SUBJECT.
