Details: On 5/14/99, Special Agent [redacted] United States Capitol Police (USCP), contacted WFO regarding a verbal threat made against Senator Jesse Helms by the above captioned subject. According to [redacted] stated during a 5/7/99 interview with the United States Secret Service (USSS) that in November 1998 he had heard voices tell him he should "kill Senator Jesse Helms." The USSS was interviewing [redacted] as a result of threats he had made against the Vice President.

A criminal history query for [redacted] white male, date of birth [redacted] was negative. According to Special Agent [redacted] USSS, [redacted]

Although the USSS interviewed [redacted] and obtained his medical records, it is unable to share this information with the FBI, and will not provide an assessment as to whether [redacted] is likely to act on his threat. Therefore, it will be necessary for the FBI to interview [redacted] to determine his exact intentions regarding Senator Helms.

Synopsis of case:

On 5/14/99, WFO was notified by the United States Capitol Police that a verbal threat had been made against Senator Jesse Helms by [Redacted] during an interview with the United States Secret Service (USSS). The USSS reported [Redacted] said he had heard voices tell him he should, "kill Senator Jesse Helms" in November 1998. USSS was interviewing [Redacted] about a threat made regarding Vice President Gore. USSS was able to share some information with WFO regarding its interview of [Redacted] but would not provide a threat assessment.

On 5/26/99, WFO sent a communication to FBI's Charlotte Division to have [Redacted] interviewed. [Redacted] was then institutionalized at St. Joseph's Hospital in Asheville, NC. On 7/13/99, Charlotte Division interviewed [Redacted] and he realized that the voices telling him to harm Senator Helms were part of a
