On June 27, 2009 at approximately 10:13 am the Raleigh Police Department responded to 3939-133 Wake Forest Rd. Raleigh, NC in reference to a deceased person. This address is within the city limits of Raleigh, NC and falls in the jurisdictional boundaries of the Raleigh Police Department. The sixty year old female was found deceased in her bedroom. Upon initial examination of the one bedroom apartment it was readily apparent personal property of the deceased is missing from the scene. The cause of death at this time is not known.

This search warrant is needed to enter the residence and conduct a search for evidence pertaining to the crime of murder, any documents with names, addresses, details of the incident, notes indicating locations, or people involved, forensic, trace. Blood, semen, saliva, physiological fluids and secretions, hair, fibers, fingerprints, palm prints, footprints, shoeprints, weapons, and firearms, including, pistols, revolvers, rifles, shotguns, hatchets, axes, cutting instruments, and cutting tools, blunt force instruments, bullets, cartridges, fired cartridges, and items containing traces of any of the above mentioned articles.

This search warrant is needed so that follow up investigation can be conducted, and the residence searched, examined, and processed for additional evidence. There is probable cause to believe that there is evidence of the crime of murder located within this residence or within the curtilage of the dwelling.

Probable Cause Affidavit

I, Detective Z.A. Morse have been a Law Enforcement Officer with the Raleigh Police Department for 13 years and 8 months. I am currently assigned to the Major Crimes Task Force of our investigative division. The primary types of cases I am assigned are death investigations. I have received training in crimes through the North Carolina Justice Academy, Raleigh Police Department's Academy, and regularly scheduled in-service training sessions dealing with laws of arrest, search and seizure, interviewing, the preparation of a search warrant and criminal investigation. I have conducted investigations that have led to the arrest and conviction of individuals for violations of North Carolina general statues. I have obtained and executed numerous search warrants in the past that have led to the arrest and conviction of suspects.



